APPLICATION

1. Have you ever prayed for something unexpected? If so, how did that prayer go?
2. Our big idea for the week was, "God's fire doesn't fall randomly or haphazardly – it falls where preparations have been made." What steps are you taking (or can you take) to prepare your life for God to move?
3. If listening to God must precede action, do you find that you skip over the listen part? How can you spend more time listening to God?
4. When in your life have you felt the most broken by God? What does it mean to submit to brokenness?
5. Do you struggle with change? When in your life have you been forced to change? How can you better embrace change when it happens?
